

## CALL FOR NOMINATIONS

### *Society for Social Work and Research*

#### **2010 OUTSTANDING SOCIAL WORK DOCTORAL DISSERTATION AWARD**

The Society for Social Work and Research *Outstanding Social Work Doctoral Dissertation Award* recognizes dissertations exemplifying high standards in social work research and scholarship. The purpose of the award is to encourage the design and conduct of quality research by doctoral-level social workers, to recognize the authors of such studies, and to provide these authors with a professional conference venue to present findings from their study.

**No later than August 3, 2009** nominators must first contact SSWR Administrative Director Jennifer Lewis via e-mail at [lewis@sswr.org](mailto:lewis@sswr.org) to register (1) the name of the nominator, (2) contact information for the nominator, (3) the name of the author, (4) contact information for the nominee, (5) the name of the major professor supervising the dissertation and (6) the name of the program and university from which the dissertation originated. The administrative director will assign a nominator number which is to be used on all nomination documents to ensure a blind review process. Self-nominations are encouraged. *Only SSWR members may submit nominations. The SSWR Board has set a policy that no sitting member of the Board may apply for this award.*

The nomination packet must include the dissertation and a nomination letter indicating the specific ways in which the dissertation advances knowledge in social work. Both files must be submitted electronically via email attachment.

To ensure a blind review process all nominators/nominees must adhere to the following guidelines;

- Use your assigned ID number in place of all occurrences of your name. Your actual name may only be shown on the Nomination ID Number Request i.e. If your assigned ID number is DA\_2010\_010, use that to identify yourself throughout your documents rather than your actual name.
- Do not reference the actual name of your institution; You can only use generic, non-identifiable names such as “My University” or “XYZ University” when referring to your institution.
- Staff and Chair names cannot be mentioned, they can only be referred to by their title i.e. Use ‘Department Chair’ instead of ‘Professor Smith’
- Applications which reveal any aspect of the applicant’s identity, affiliation, or staff names will NOT be considered.

The award recipient will be honored at the Awards Ceremony at the 2010 conference. Recipients of the Award will receive complimentary conference registration, a stipend for travel to the conference, a plaque and a honorarium.

**Eligibility criteria:** Eligible nominees must have successfully defended their doctoral dissertation between July 1, 2008 and June 30, 2009. The dissertation must originate from a member program of the *Group for the Advancement of Doctoral Education in Social Work*.
